COURSE DETAILS

- Course to be launched on **Tuesday**, 22nd July 2025
- Batch size: 100 participants
- Hybrid course. Online classes for 3 months, followed by physical contact session (PCS) for 2 days with exit examination.
- Tuesday sessions (9 pm 10.30 pm), and add-on sessions on Fridays (9 pm 10.30 pm).
- Pre-test/post-test in each session
- Monthly quiz and doubt-clearing sessions.
- Course material will be provided in soft copy. No hard copy will be provided
- Post-live session, the lectures will be accessible online for the registered candidates for **the course duration ONLY** (3 months)

Important: Seventy-five (75%) attendance in LIVE SESSIONS is mandatory for eligibility for exit exams and certification.

EXIT EXAM : (TOTAL 100 MARKS)

- OSCE : 20 Questions. 20 marks. (30 mnts)
- Exit exams : Online at PCS. 80 Questions. 80 marks. (Test duration: 90 minutes)
- No negative marks
- 60% aggregate for certification
- IAP-NRC decision is final & binding
- If missed, can attend the next PCS with an additional exam fee of INR 1000

FAQ

1. What would happen if my attendance falls short in online classes?

You will not be eligible to attend the Personal Contact Session (PCS) and Exit exams.

2. I have attended all online classes, but I am unable to appear for PCS. Can I attend PCS of future courses?

Yes. You can attend the PCS and Exit exams in next batch with payment of additional INR 1000/ only . But no online / recorded sessions will be available for you.

3. I could not attend the online course due to illness. Would I get my fee refunded?

No. The fees are non-refundable under any circumstances.

4. Would IAPNRC Provide me accommodation and travel allowance for PCS?

No. These are participant's responsibility.

5. Would IAPNRC provide me food during PCS?

Only Lunch and Tea/coffee will be provided to you from IAP-NRC.

6. What would happen if I am unable to clear PCS exit exam?

You can attend the next PCS and exit exams with additional payment of INR 1000/.

7. Can I ask for revaluation of my answer sheet for exit exam?

No. The decision of IAP-NRC is final and binding.
